Scholarship Fund Objective

The Greater Austin Contractors and Engineers Association (ACEA) scholarship fund provides financial assistance to youth pursuing educational opportunities in the construction and/or engineering career fields that will enhance the Central Texas community. The scholarship fund provides annual grants to high school seniors in variable amounts and terms determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee and/or the ACEA Board of Directors.

History of the Scholarship Fund

The Greater Austin Contractors and Engineers Association Scholarship Fund was initiated in 2003 to benefit the community at large. Maintained through fund raising activities and donations from member firms, the fund is administered by the Scholarship Committee under the guidance of the ACEA Board of Directors.

Scholarship Application Requirements

All applicants shall meet the following minimum requirements to be eligible for the ACEA scholarship:

1. Hold high school senior level in the current school year at the time of application
2. Reside in Travis, Williamson, Burnet, Blanco, Hays, Caldwell or Bastrop Counties during their senior year of high school
3. Complete an ACEA scholarship application which can be obtained at www.aceatx.com and includes general information, career goals, scholastic achievement, community involvement, and basis financial information. Grades and test scores to meet the requirements of the college, university, trade, technical or business school of their choice must also be included.
4. Complete a brief essay (300-500 words) about yourself and your career goals (to be included with application).

Scholarship Award Process

Applications are screened by an impartial committee and scholarships are awarded to deserving students with the consent of the ACEA Board of Directors.

Scholarships are \$2,000 for the first year with an additional \$3,000 awarded if a GPA of 3.0 or better is obtained during the first year. Payment will be initiated in August of the following school year upon presentation of proof of registration by the recipient.
